

B. Wiring Diagram



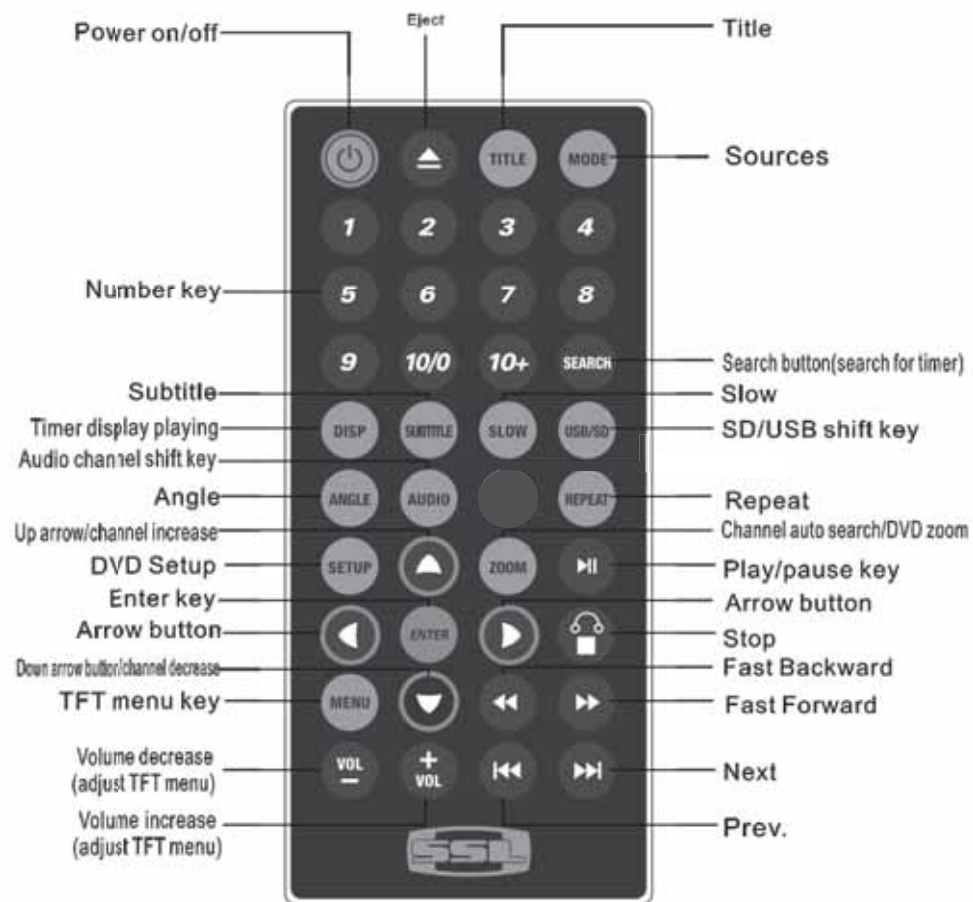

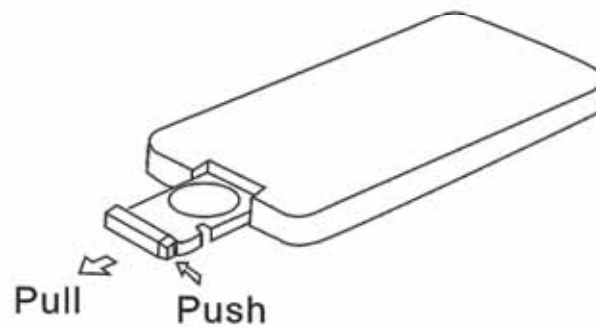


D.Remote control function description



E. Remote Control Operation and Battery Care

1. Reference to instruction for remote control (shown as pictures), pull out the battery tray and insert the battery (type CR2025) with the stamped (+) mark facing upward. Insert the battery tray into the remote control.
2. Direct the remote controller to infrared receiver window of the machine within 60 degrees and 5 m without any barriers between them.
3. Commonly the life-span of the batteries is about one year, always replace the old set of new batteries.
4. Please pull out the separation film before when using the remote controller.



WARNING:

Store the battery where children cannot reach; Do not recharge, disassemble the battery. Dispose of properly.

G. Menu setup

Menu setup method:

Enter the menu: press  button on remote control panel, or press MENU

Up/down button: move cursor to choose the item you need

Right/left button: move cursor to choose the item you need

Play/pause button: confirm the item you want

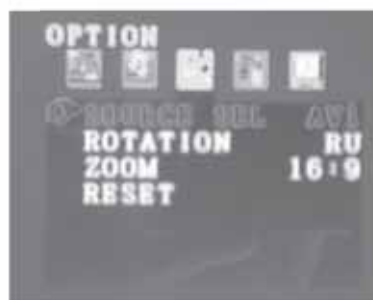

I.USB/SD function

1. At the state of DVD, can switch the function of DVD/USB/SD by  button on the remote control panel (please press stop button when DVD are playing)
2. Press stop button and press  button again then can recover DVD state when playing USB/SD.

J.Attention

1.Disc

- ◆ Wipe a soft lint free cloth
- ◆ Don't touch the playback side of the disc,hold the disc by the edges so that fingerprints will not get on the surface
- ◆ Don't stick paper or tape on the disc
- ◆ Don't expose the disc to direct sunlight or sources of heat
- ◆ After playing, store the disc in its case
- ◆ Before playing a disc, make sure the disc is free from any debris or scratches.
- ◆ Don't use strong solvents such as alcohol, benzene, thinner

2.Special instructions

There may be a few bright or dark spots on the screen when plays

It is a very common phenomenon in active matrix display technology. It does not indicate any fault or problem has appeared

Troubleshooting

Fault	Cause	Solution
No power	+/- electrodes connected in opposite way	Connect red wire to + 12v, black wire to ground
	Faulty fuse	Change with new fuse
No image	No video signal	Check signal cable
	No DVD signal	Re-start player
Remote control does not work properly	Remove protective film before use	Remove the insulating label from the remote controller
	Intermittent functions	Remote has to be have a "line of sight" and can be no further than 6 ft
	Remote not functioning	Replace battery
Distorted Picture	Disc is damaged or scratched	Try another disc
	Remove	Insert disc again correctly
